

## **BOARD OF ENGINEERING OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO**

In accordance with Clause 16 (f) of the Engineering Profession Act, Chap. 90:01, Laws of Trinidad and Tobago, the Board of Engineering of Trinidad and Tobago lists hereunder the qualifications and institutions recognized by the Board in respect of the engineering training to professional engineer level required by the Act:-

- (i) Institutions and qualifications on the published list of the Engineering Council headquartered in England as qualification to the Chartered or Professional Engineer standard.
- (ii) Institutions and qualifications on the published list of the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology headquartered in the U.S.A. as qualification to the Chartered or Professional Engineer standard.
- (iii) Institutions and qualifications on the published list of the Canadian Engineering Accreditation Board headquartered in Canada to Chartered or Professional Engineer standard.
- (iv) Other qualifications and institutions as may be approved by the Board from time to time as qualification of internationally acceptable Chartered or Professional Engineer Level.

All persons whose eligibility for registration with the Board commences in January 2015 must provide evidence of "further learning", in addition to an accredited Bachelor's degree in Engineering. Further learning may be attained by an appropriate, recognised Master's degree or an accumulation of similar type academic knowledge.

Applicants graduating prior to 2009 or those who hold a degree which is accredited to chartered engineering status will not be affected.
